## **PREREQUISITES**

Fifteen years of age

## **OBJECTIVES**

- Satisfaction of the state of California requirements for issuance of a “Certificate of Completion of Classroom Driver’s Education”
- Demonstration of mastery of the California Vehicle code regulations

## **CONTENT**

- The driving task
- Road conditions
- Effects of drugs and alcohol on the driving task
- Steering
- Parking
- Controlling speed and direction
- Decision making
- Executing in traffic
- Driving in cities and on highways
- Coping with adverse conditions and emergencies
- Buying, insuring, and maintaining an automobile

## **SKILLS**

Development of the skills, awareness, and judgment necessary for making driving decisions

## **METHODS**

Textbook work with reading assignments, written exercises, and tests. At the end of the course, students take practice DMV written tests.

## **HOMEWORK**

Readings and written exercises are completed both in and outside the classroom.

## **GRADING/CREDIT**

Daily assignments and tests are graded on a point scale.

### **INDIVIDUALIZATION**

The course is self-paced according to the ability and motivation of the student.

### **ABSENCES/TARDIES**

Absences and tardies will result in lengthening the time required to complete the course and receive a certificate of completion.
