PREREQUISITES

11th grade

OBJECTIVES

The class is discussion and writing intensive and is designed to increase student's analytical and communication skills. Emphasis is on class discussion/participation and on the development of each individual student's writing skills.

CONTENT

The class will focus on developing critical analysis, literacy analysis, formal and creative writing, research development and writing, vocabulary and advanced dictionary skills through a wide variety of literature, spanning multiple genre. Students will be exposed to both classic and contemporary literature and will gain an overall perspective of literature based on similarities and differences of each.

SKILLS

METHODS

The class is based on hands-on writing development. Outside reading and writing is assigned for each literacy subject.

HOMEWORK

Homework mainly consists of outside reading and writing assignments.

GRADING/CREDITS

Grade is based on participation, vocabulary tests, reading quizzes, writing assignments, and class presentations.

INDIVIDUALIZATION

A variety of outside reading texts are used to accommodate individual reading abilities. The class is designed to access student improvement in terms of writing skills and thus different levels of writing ability can be accommodated.

ABSENCES/TARDIES

Excessive tardies or absences will result in lower grade and/or loss of credit.
