PREREQUISITES

Approval of the Classroom Teacher.

OBJECTIVES

Students gain knowledge and confidence in their abilities to aide other students in chosen subject area.

They will learn the skills and methods necessary to communicate difficult ideas while being able to sympathize with individual needs. They will learn to work with the master teacher honestly and politely. The goal is to create a class atmosphere which best facilitates full learning in a non-threatening, non-judgmental setting.
