- **Dumbarton Express:** weekday express bus service across the Dumbarton Bridge, connecting Union City (BART), Fremont, Newark, Menlo Park and Palo Alto.

- **Caltrain:** provides commuter rail service between San Francisco and Gilroy. The closest Mid-Pen stop is Menlo Park. There is also a free Caltrain Shuttle that connects the Menlo Park Caltrain station and Mid-Peninsula High School. Many Mid-Pen students take the shuttle.
